Month of Ramadan



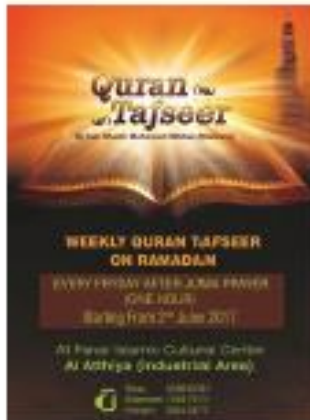
